MEMORIES OF MY UNFALTERING FAITH

I Zeenath Ara, Principal and Lecturer in Urdu department thank whole heartedly the management staff and students for their complete cooperation and untiring support in my tenure as headmistress of BET Sufia High School and Principal of BET Composite Pu College.

I started my career as a high school teacher in 1981 in East West English School at Rajajinagar. I could recall and recollect those days when people hardly believed that I can bring high school students (boys) under control. I enjoyed preparing tricky question papers in maths. We met for first staff meeting. A very senior teacher of nursery section proposed my name for staff secretary. I was in fix .Later I realized that this is called 'experience'. The same thing happened when the VC of KSOU minutes after inauguration declared our college as examination centre. When enquired by someone he looked at me and said "I am sure she can do it". I am of the opinion that words or phrases of this type will take a person long way and perform beyond their capabilities.

In 1984, reluctantly, I Joined Al-Ameen High school because I had heard a lot of misappropriation in Muslim managed institutions. 8 years flew like 8 minutes but has left few long lasting sweet memories. How can I not quote the name of our great head master Janab Syed Rasool a dedicated, honest, hardworking personality. It is only because of his inspiration, guidance and wise advises, I am standing in a place where I am now. May Allah Subhanavtala rest his soul in peace and reward him of the highest place in jannah. Ameen!

As I go along let me brief you up with my colleagues of Al-Ameen. We can never forget those days. We were a team of four, enjoyed our duties to the maximum extent. We never felt the burden of work. Although our general holidays were less, we use to have 5 to 6 casual leave at credit on 31st December. Madam Iqbalunnisa, the way we ragged you, the memories are still afresh in my heart and madam Sufiya Naaz. I owe a lot to you. You have shared a lot of knowledge and guided me.

In July 1992, I joined BET Sufia High School as Headmistress and Al-hamdulilah is completing my tenure as the Principal of an Aided Pu College. Being a private charitable institution, it is highly difficult to retain the faculty both teaching and non teaching. Non teaching staff is an asset to the institution because it is only they who build records and maintain it. Reputation of a college is hypen the result and the discipline. Hence, having dedicated teachers and lecturers is mandatory. Al-hamdulilah, after a long struggle Pu staff seems to be well-set with four aided lecturers, now it is right time they are carved out which in turn reflects the reputation of the college. Bismillahnagar is dominated by socially, economically backward Muslim community. The moment you try to impose discipline. They will revolt. More so in the past, we had to face a lot of hardships convincing them and realizing importance of these facts. The key factor of any college is discipline. Now, I feel graduating the girls will become simply superficial if we fail to bring in a change in the society. It is the parents who are to be educated. The environment at home should be changed. This is giving birth to lot of wrong deeds. Sometimes the girls feel that they are insecure at home. Knowingly or unknowingly they try to seek solution to their problems themselves and take in wrong track. Parents are unaware of their responsibilities in upbringing up their children. They try to seek monetary benefits from various sources on falsehood. Should the building be strong, the pillars have to be strong. Hence, educate, literate and bring in awareness !!!!!!!

I would like to mention a few colleagues of mine; nevertheless all are equally important and have supported me in running the show.

Mrs. Shahla kakhshan, who was instrumental in introducing me to BET well mannered, sincere and honest teacher in Kannada.

I remember those days when she and Mrs. Husna suroor use to stitch uniforms after school hours, while I used to complete the complete official records. Mrs. Shaista Tabassum, Mrs. Syeda Romana, Mrs. Maqsoda, Mrs. Sayeeda Begum are a few to mention, Mrs. Prizulla, a wonderful maths teachers. A dedicated humble lady, the senior most, May Allah SWT bestows his choicest blessings upon her and her family – Madam Sadiqunnisa.

A Matchless professor, editor of a journal who works day and night for the improvement of college. A soul who took NAAC single handed. A teacher with motherly attachment to girls (that too of degree)- Madam Sumaiya Fathima.

I pray to give Allah SWT for health and grant us courage to throw away the negatives from our mind and heart. There is no supplement to “forget and forgiveness”. The change can be felt in our personal as well as professional life thereafter. Let virtual barriers not stop us from reaching the heights of the sky.

Alhamdulillah, the year 2012 our college was under salary grants for four lecturers and one SDA. These 6 years are painful period for me. 20 long years have just flown away as 20 days. I just cannot imagine these 20 years they have passed like a dream. Every morning thereafter I have to ask myself if I have to report my duty or quit. I have to convince myself and proceed for duty.

Hey!!! Don't be misguided I have done justice to my duty whatsoever. I have never ever cheated my profession anyway. Had I been a money monger, I could have encashed my subjects (maths) and minted money but never. Allah SWT has given me contentment. I have the ability to introspect myself analyze the problems and find the solution. This of course, demand time & patience but has helped me to do things better. I sought suggestions from various people and even met the DDPU for transfer but in vain.

I have never tried to satisfy my superiors. Of course respect is a different issue. I respect them a lot.

This article / write-up may be incomplete without the name of Janab B.Abdul salam Faiz. It was he who introduced me to south teachers' complex as a resource person in 1985. Then on I was a resource person several times. I was adjudged as “Best Teacher” by Al-Ameen Arts, Science and Commerce College 2001.

COLLEGE HISTORY SINCE INCEPTION

BET institution was born out of the educational vision of Late Janab S.A. Shukoor. His vision was of bringing education and knowledge to the weakest sections of the society. He started out with the initiative of the school education for the deprived and marginalized classes in the southern part of Bangalore City. He, along with a few members as volunteers in this task, with 21 trustees started Bismillah Educational Trust, with the sole motive of educating girls. On 2nd october 1985 Bismillah Educational Trust came into existence and Gulzar-e-Nau-Nihal Nursery School was inaugurated by Late Janab S A Shukoor at Bismillah Nagar and Mavalli in the presence of Late Janab Mir Maqsood Ali Khan and Janab Abdul Wajid ,AEO.

A year later BET Primary school was established at Bismillah Nagar. First ever calander was released by late AlHaj Azeez Sait Saheb, on 18th November to generate funds towards the institutions. As time progressed , within a short span of time BET Sufia Girls High School was established with the permission granted by the Government of Karnataka.

Following it, in the year 1994, BET Composite PU College for girls was established. It was inaugurated by Dr Mumtaz Ahmed Khan, founder, Al-Ameen Movement on 26th June 1994. Late AlHaj Moulana Riyaz-ur-Rehman Saheb Rashadi, Mr. K. Rehman Khan, Mr C.R. Sagheer Ahmed, Mr Ramalinga Reddy, Mr Sadat Ali Khan, Corporator Mr Ramaiah and others also graced the ocassion. Alhamdulillah, PUC is growing stronger day by day since the inception.

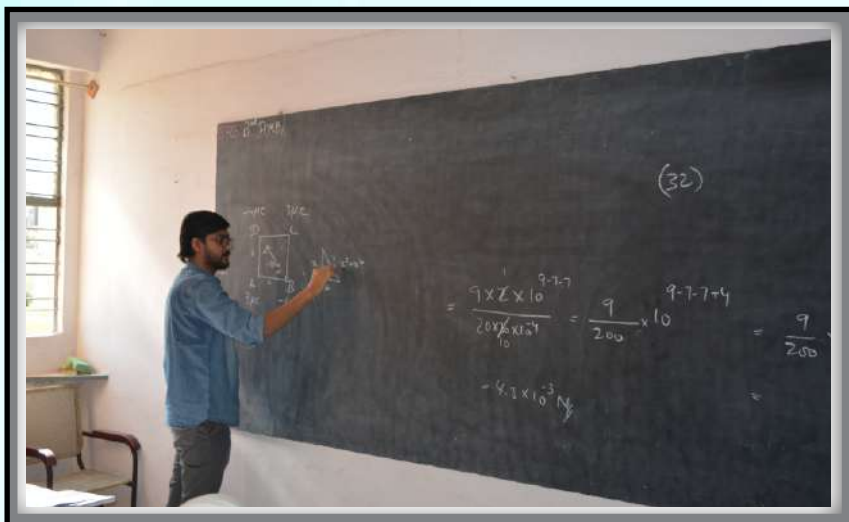

ARTICLE ON MINDFULNESS



'Mindfulness' is a word we hear a lot these days, but what exactly does it mean?

Find out what it is, what the benefits of mindfulness are and how you can start to practice it.

WHAT EXACTLY IS MINDFULNESS?

When we are mindful, we are more conscious of our thoughts, our actions and what is happening around us. We might notice a beautiful sunset or really listen carefully to what a friend is saying, rather than planning what we are going to say next. We are also more aware of our own feelings and our thoughts. Mindfulness is-

“PAYING ATTENTION, ON PURPOSE, IN THE PRESENT MOMENT, AND WITHOUT JUDGING”.

WHY IS MINDFULNESS SO POPULAR NOW?

For most people life is getting busier and busier. Technology means that we always have something to do and there isn't much opportunity to just 'be'. People are often doing two or three things at the same time, texting while watching TV or even looking at their phone while walking along the pavement. Mindfulness can be a way of reducing this stress.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF MINDFULNESS?

Research shows that mindfulness reduces stress and depression. It can help you to concentrate, have a better memory and to think more clearly. It can also help people to manage pain better and to improve their sleep, and it can even help you lose weight because you won't eat that whole packet of biscuits without thinking.

HOW TO BECOME MORE MINDFUL?

A very simple technique that you could try right now is to close your eyes for a couple of minutes and count how many sounds you can hear. This will help you to focus on what is happening right now.

Another technique is to focus on a piece of food, typically a raisin. Instead of eating it without thinking, slow down. Looking carefully at it and notice how it feels in your fingers. Smell it. Then put it on your tongue and taste it. Only then start to eat it slowly, noticing how it feels and how it tastes.

Both of these techniques force you to slow down and focus on the present moment.

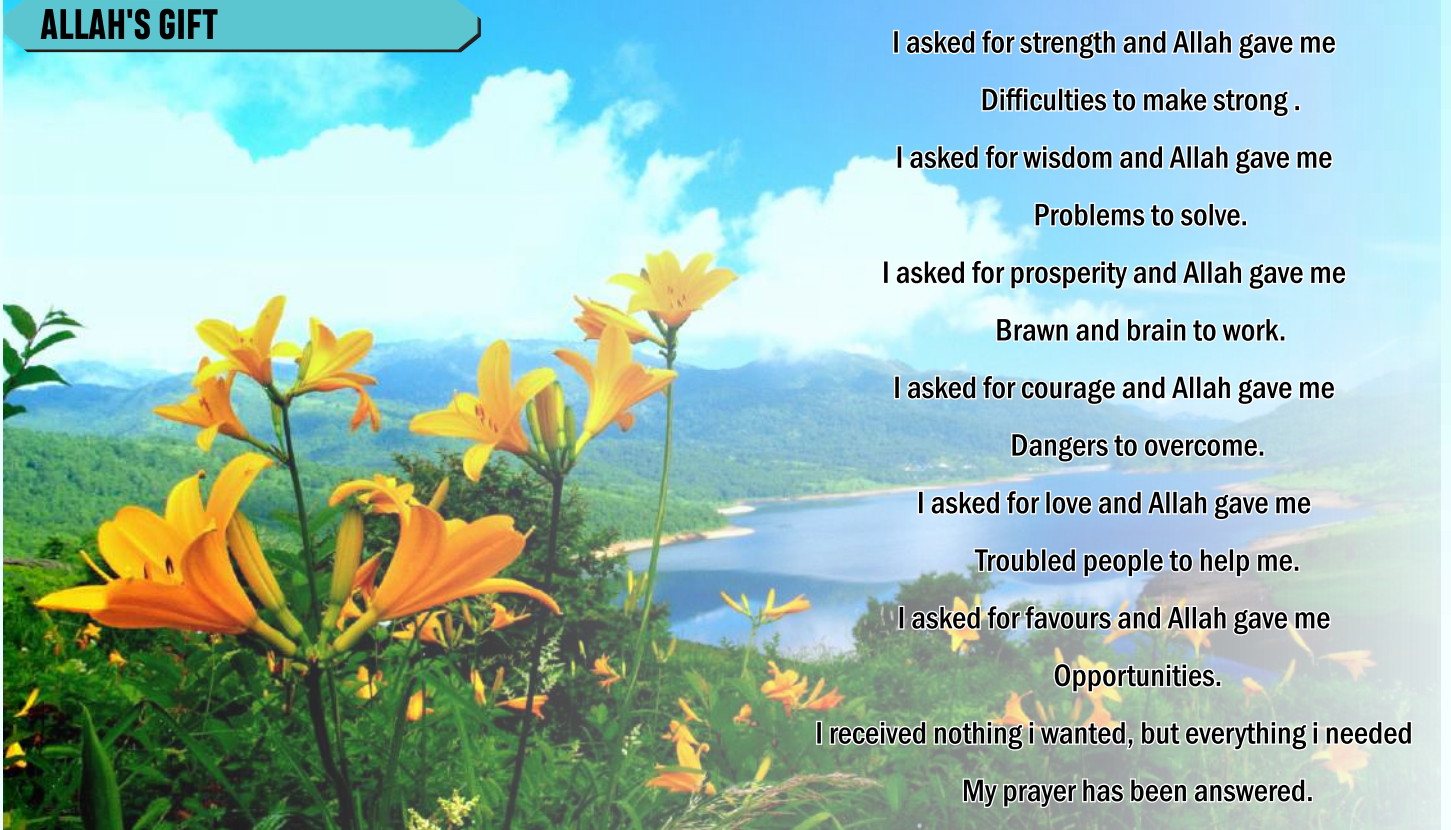

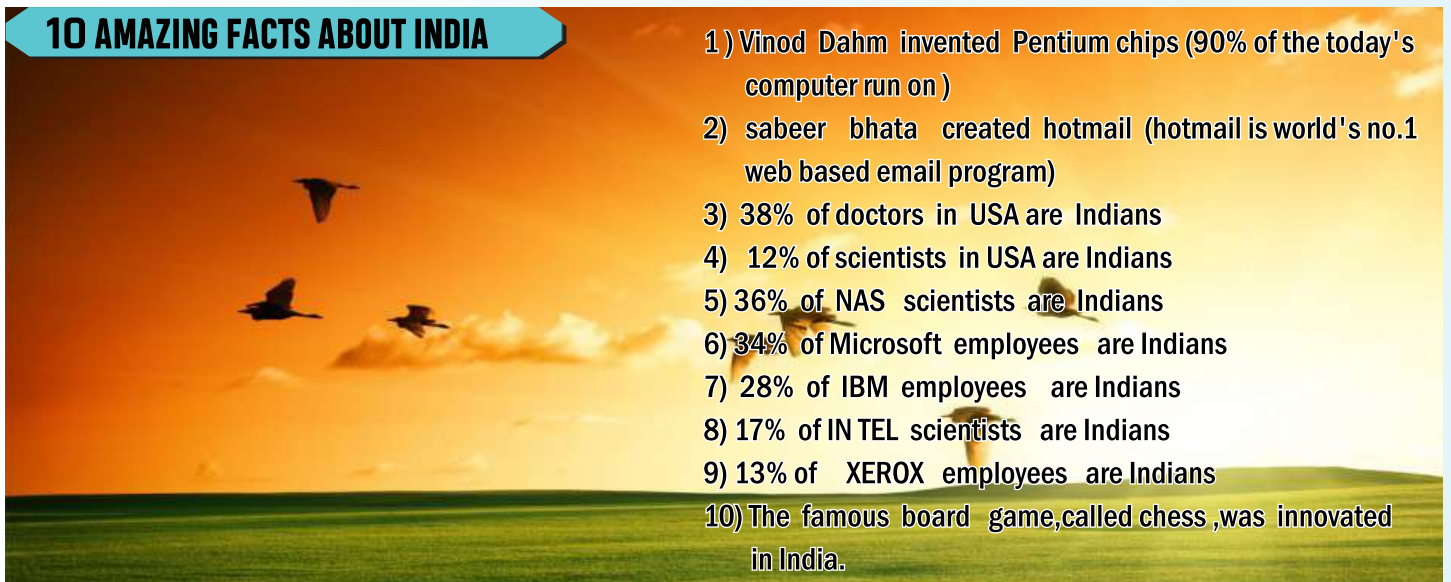

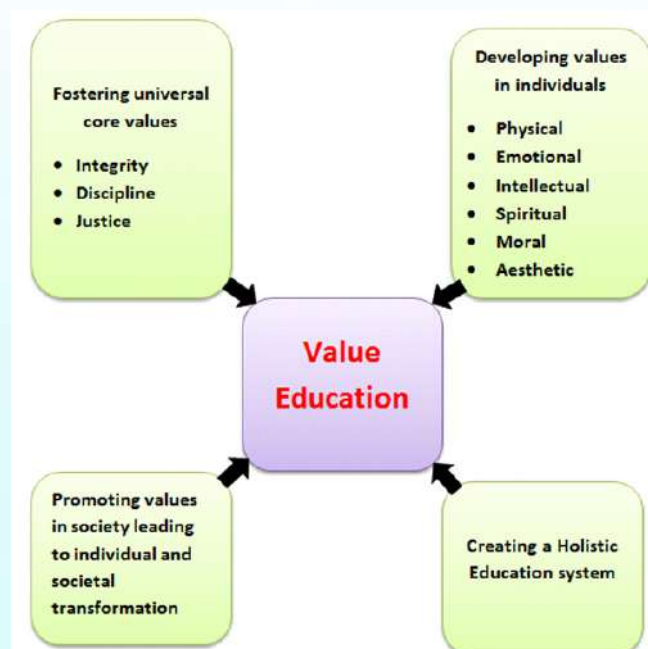

It is better assumed when combined with other values: a disposition that is deeper than graciousness, very close to consideration, and approaching appreciation. Truly, to respect someone, one must be able to appreciate some of his/her human qualities, even if one does not appreciate his/her opinions or past behavior.

Several universal human values such as Truth, Righteous conduct, Peace, Love and Non- violence are directly associated to physical, intellectual, emotional psyche and spiritual facets of human personality. There is need and urgency to reinforce these values for a better and humane society. These are described below:

Co-operation: It is the procedure to work jointly to attain some goal, but many scholars visualize co-operation as a luxury and not an important human value.

Honesty: Honesty is also vital human values. Presently, adopting an honest approach can often feel intimidating and impossible, but people fail to realize is that it is not the act of simply telling the truth that makes someone honest rather the quality of person who is being honest. An honest person is often straight, upright, sincere and fair and being an honest person brings more reward to the soul than the damage a lie could do.

Love: The presence of love in human life, the love they have for their families, friends, our faith and for themselves is important source of energy to lead smooth life.

Respect: Respect is a feeling of deep esteem for someone or something elicited by their abilities, qualities, or achievements.

Faith: Faith is complete trust or confidence in someone or something.

Beauty: Beauty is something that has really been spoiled by human society. The way we think about something that is beautiful is judged on a purely physical response, but the true meaning of beauty is being in balance and harmony with nature.

Trust: Trust can be understood in many ways, but finally it comes down to reliability and truth. Without trust, the world simply would not function.

Integrity: As a human value, integrity is imperative that people stand spiritually undivided and hold true to our integrity, the importance of which is often forgotten.

Wisdom: Wisdom is also significant human value in many ways; under-appreciated in its importance, in its value in our lives and in its true meaning. Wisdom is also very often confused with words like knowledge or intelligence but the word wisdom is defined as the quality of having experience and good judgment and the resulting soundness of that action or decision.

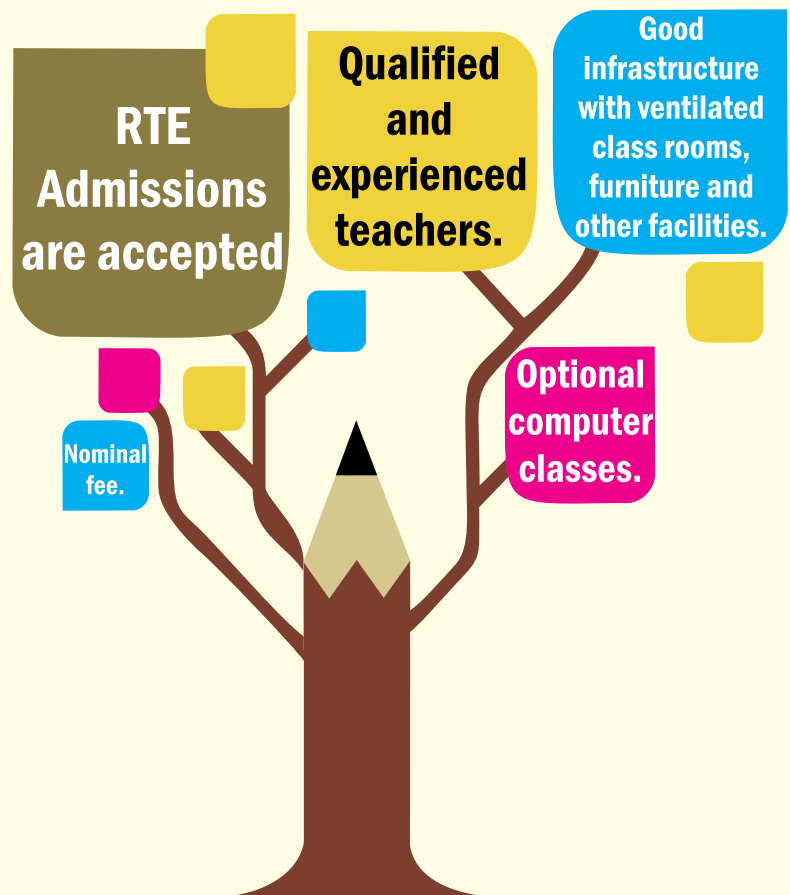
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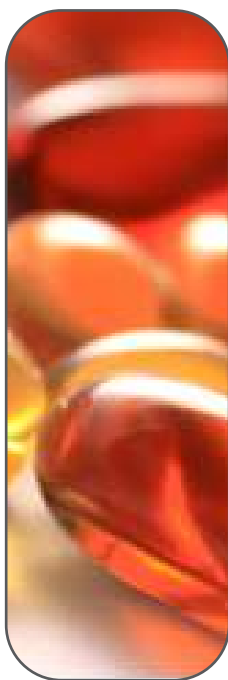
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
