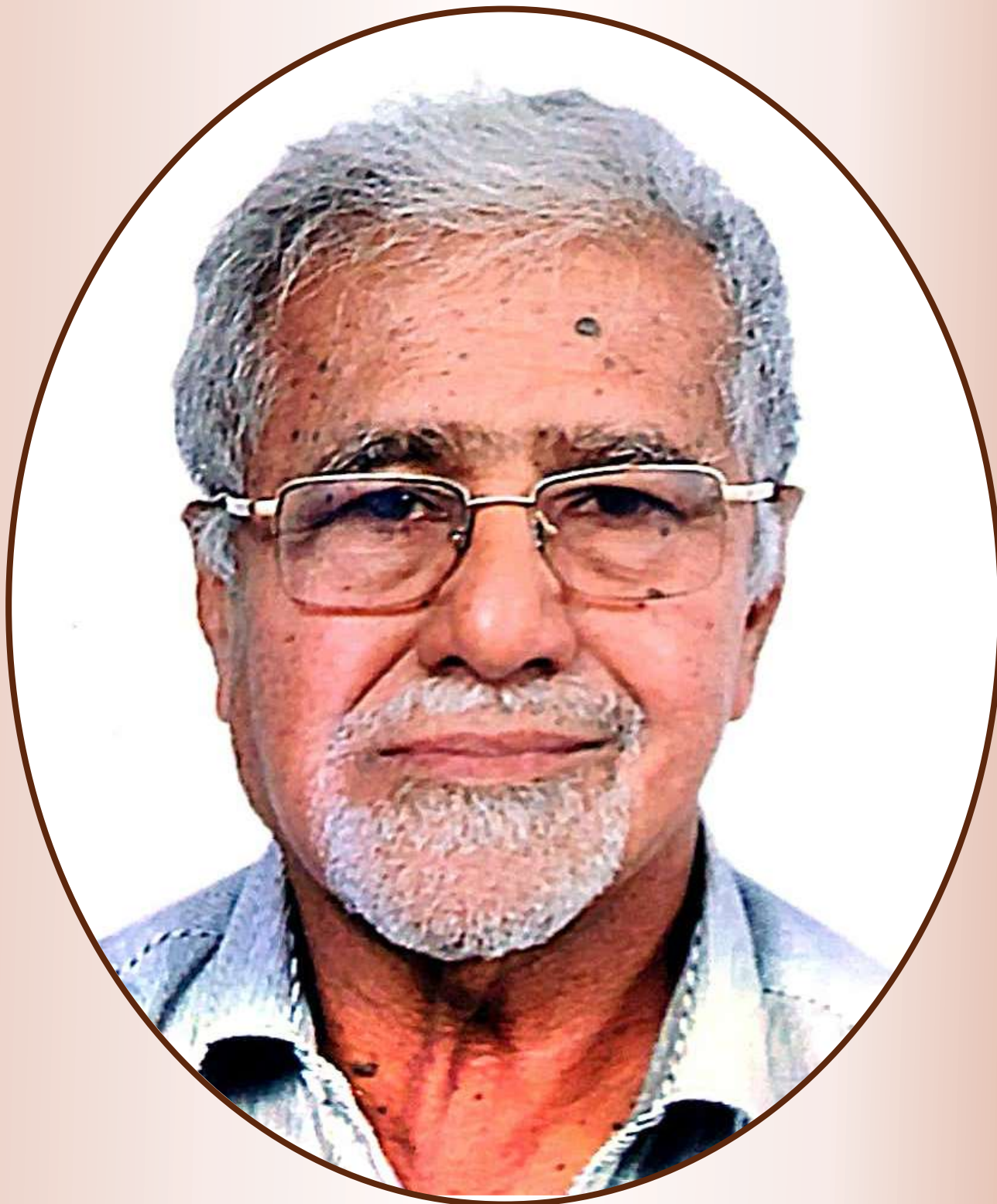

ABOUT COLLEGE :

B.E.T COMPOSITE PU COLLEGE since its inception in 1994 with an objective to impart quality education to girl children, the college has grown by leaps and bounds. The honorary management members have put their heart and soul in growing our institution to this level and have never hesitated to walk an extra mile to ensure the overall development of students. . There are 20 teaching faculty and 15 non-teaching staff members who serve 399 girls students hailing from educationally and economically backward families.

INFRASTRUCTURE :

The year 2019 - 2020 marked the completion of 25 years of B.E.T Composite PU College. As a mark of silver jubilee celebrations the college laboratories, libraries, sports room, cafeteria and indoor stadium were revamped and redesigned.

Physics Lab : Physics lab provides an experimental foundation for the theoretical concept introduced in the lectures to familiarise students with an experimental apparatus and analyse data with scientific method.

Chemistry Lab : Chemistry lab has all the necessary equipments and chemicals required for preparation of samples and standards for various analyses of liquid and solid samples by students.

Biology Lab : Biology lab consists of simple and compound microscopes for the students to focus and study slides. The lab has all sorts of facilities ranging from specimens to permanent anatomical slides.

Computer Lab : Computer lab offers a space for students to explore, create, connect and build digital literacy. Our lab comprises of 33 systems with internet facility and projector LCD for smart learning.

Reference and E-library : Our reference library comprises 14, 322 books to cater the needs of students. Our e-library provides around the clock online access digitized audio, video, and written material. It provides free copies of books, journals, etc. to our students and staff. Book Bank Scheme was initiated to support the needy and deserving students. A total of 205 books were donated by the current outgoing II PUC Students.

Sports Room : Our Sports room comprises of various play equipments. This room is specially designed for indoor games like Carom, Chess, mind games etc as these games have important role to play in growth and development of mind and body of our students.



Indoor stadium : Indoor stadium is an integrated facility for sports activity with provisions for training athletes and hosting of district and state level events like Table tennis, kabadi, khokho, tug of war etc.

Cafeteria : Our college canteen is a store that sells food & drink to our staff and students at reasonable prices so as to make available to them a balanced and hygienic food.

Spacious classroom : A well-furnished classroom with ICT facility helps students avoid being distracted and focus more on the classroom teaching.

Prayer hall : Prayer hall allow students to step off the busy roller coaster ride and pause breathe and unite their mind, body and spirit.

Transportation facility : Transport services were initiated in the year 2016 as it's a very essential service with regard to students' safety. Our buses carry GPS trackers as well.

CCTV Surveillance : The college is under 24/7 CCTV surveillance providing security and safety to the students and staff.

Generator : The generator and UPS systems provide back up to our primary source. They help to protect our electronic devices from damage and also, help us during power outage maintaining an efficient power supply.

Purified Drinking water : Our college has an RO plant installed that gives us 24/7 purified drinking water.

Sanitary Napkin vending Machine : Girls studying in any institution require staff and management that not just look into their academic and physical well being but also their health and hygiene, even when it comes to girls sensitive issues. Keeping this in mind sanitary napkin vending machines is installed

Eco- Friendly Environment : The College Campus is filled with lush green perfectly maintained green plants with vertical gardens aligned making the atmosphere of the college eco-friendly.

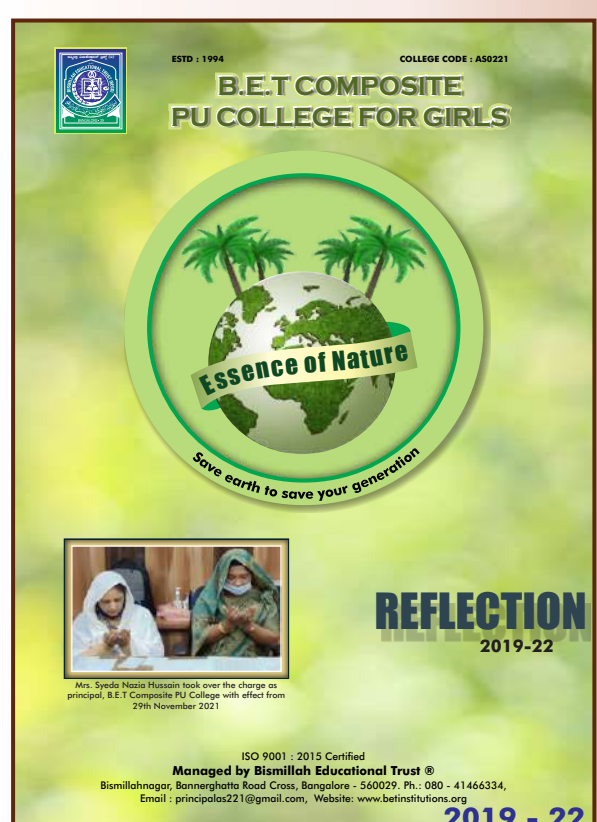
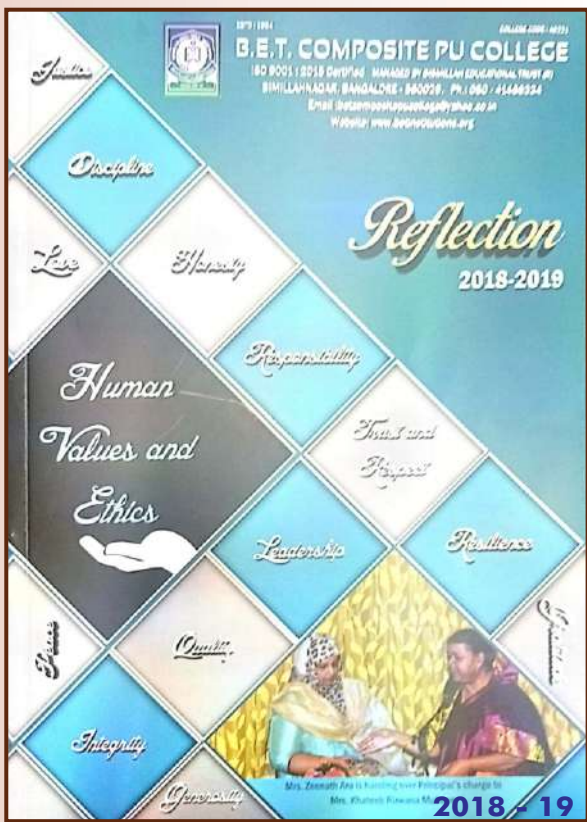
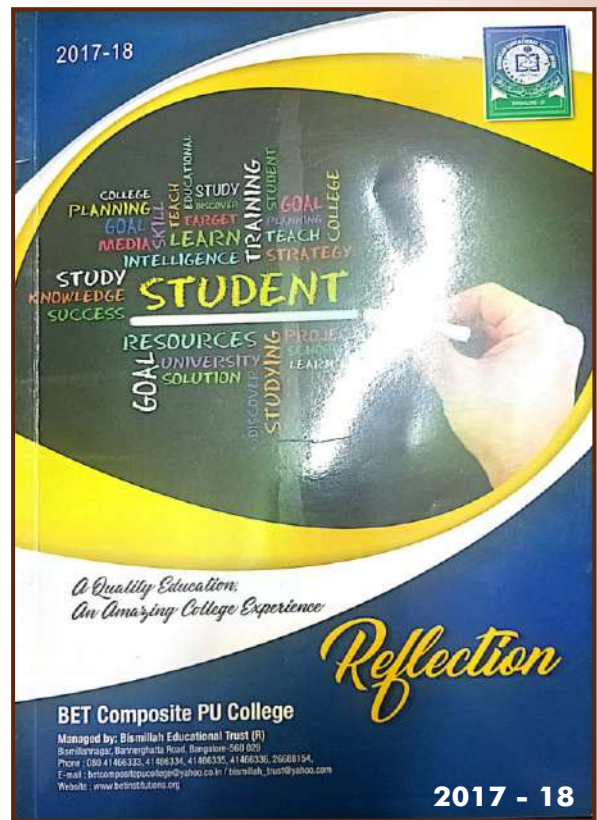
Internet Facility : Our College is equipped with internet facility throughout the campus

In the present times, girls in fact are bringing a lot of accolades to its family and nation as a whole in every field including sports, politics, entertainment, corporate world, wrestling, etc.

But people still have that old school mentality that girls are rather a liability and thus, various people started getting sex of the child determined before its birth and aborting the girl child in the womb itself. This practice is more prevalent in rural areas and villages,

urban places are not absolutely unaffected though. The primary reason behind these ill-practices is due to the increase in the crime against women.

This initiative received grand response and approximately 70 students have already received an opportunity to spend a day with different types of professionals; the girls see them operating in a professional environment which not only inspire them, but would also help them in taking informed decisions about their career.

FEMALE LEGENDS OF INDIAN HISTORY

Women and their sacrifices are undoubtedly a significant part of the ancient and mediaeval period in Indian history. They have always proved themselves equal to or even greater than men in every field.

1. Rani Lakshmi Bai

“Khoob Ladi Mardani Vo Toh Jhansi Wali Rani Thi” is a tribute to the bravest woman fighter in India. She fought tooth and nail against the British Army carrying a newborn child at her back with the horse's reins in her mouth. Lakshmi Bai never agreed to surrender and kept fighting till death because it was not a piece of land but her respect and dignity which was at stake.

2. Razia Begum

An epitome of courage and bravery, Razia Begum was the first and the last woman Sultan of Delhi. Carrying her father's legacy forward, she kept on fighting for her identity, against all odds prevailing in the society that was continuously conspiring against her. She ferociously fought along with her army and was defeated by her own brother Muizuddin Bahram Shah and was imprisoned at Qila Mubarak in Bathinda.

3. Anandi Bai Joshi

Anandi Bai Gopal Rao Joshi was the first female Indian Physician. She was forcefully married at the age of 9 and conceived her first child at the age of 14. Due to a lack of proper medical care, the child passed away within 10 days, and that was the defining moment in her life. She decided to practise medical sciences backed up by the full support of her husband. She completed her medical course at the Women's Medical College of Pennsylvania and even inspired many women in India to study medical education. She died at the early age of 22 due to Tuberculosis, even before she could practise medicine in her country. But she left a legacy of strength and courage behind her which enlightened many of the women around her.

4. Savitri Bai Phule

Along with being the first female teacher in India, Savitri Bai Phule was a social reformer who was keen to help women break free from the shackles of caste discrimination, inequality, and the lack of education. Along with the support of her husband, she broke many social barriers, one of which included opening the first school for girls when it was unacceptable for women to gain an education. Besides her social work, Savitri Bai even encouraged people through her literary works to fight for their rights.

WORKPLACE CHALLENGES FOR YOUNG WOMEN

Despite significant progress in gender equality, many challenges persist for young women workplace.

These include:

The gender pay gap is a persistent issue. Women, on average, earn less than men for the same roles and responsibilities. This pay gap exists across multiple industries and on a global level. Forbes reports that, worldwide, "on average, women earn 77 cents for every dollar earned by men," and that "at the current rate, it is estimated that it will take 257 years to close the global gender pay gap." This disparity is a pressing financial concern that also impacts women's morale and self-worth.

Career progression for young women is often stymied by invisible barriers, commonly referred to as the 'glass ceiling'. These barriers can be a result of deep-rooted biases or organizational structures that systematically favor men.

Young women often face societal and professional stereotypes. These biases can range from questioning their leadership capabilities to making assumptions about their personal lives and choices. Stereotypes can pigeonhole young women into certain roles or responsibilities, often sidelining them from opportunities that could lead to career advancement. Additionally, facing constant bias can lead to feelings of alienation and dissatisfaction in the workplace. This can result in reduced motivation, lower productivity, and even decisions to leave a job or change career paths

MOTHER TERESA

Mother Teresa was born Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu in Uskup, Ottoman Empire (now Skopje, North Macedonia), on August 26, 1910. Her family was of Albanian descent. At the age of twelve, she felt strongly the call of God. She knew she had to be a missionary to spread the love of Christ. At the age of eighteen she left her parental home in Skopje and joined the Sisters of Loreto, an Irish community of nuns with missions in India.

After a few months' training in Dublin she was sent to India, where on May 24, 1931, she took her initial vows as a nun. From 1931 to 1948 Mother Teresa taught at St. Mary's High

School in Calcutta, but the suffering and poverty she glimpsed outside the convent walls made such a deep impression on her that in 1948 she received permission from her superiors to leave the convent school and devote herself to working among the poorest of the poor in the slums of Calcutta. Although she had no funds, she depended on Divine Providence, and started an open-air school for slum children. Soon she was joined by voluntary helpers, and financial support was also forthcoming. This made it possible for her to extend the scope of her work.

On October 7, 1950, Mother Teresa received permission from the Holy See to start her own order, "The Missionaries of Charity", whose primary task was to love and care for those persons nobody was prepared to look after. In 1965 the Society became an International Religious Family by a decree of Pope Paul VI.

Today the order comprises Active and Contemplative branches of Sisters and Brothers in many countries. In 1963 both the Contemplative branch of the Sisters and the Active branch of the Brothers was founded. In 1979 the Contemplative branch of the Brothers was added, and in 1984 the Priest branch was established.

The Society of Missionaries has spread all over the world, including the former Soviet Union and Eastern European countries. They provide effective help to the poorest of the poor in a number of countries in Asia, Africa, and Latin America, and they undertake relief work in the wake of natural catastrophes such as floods, epidemics, and famine, and for refugees. The order also has houses in North America, Europe and Australia, where they take care of the shut-ins, alcoholics, homeless, and AIDS sufferers.

The Missionaries of Charity throughout the world are aided and assisted by Co-Workers who became an official International Association on March 29, 1969. By the 1990s there were over one million Co-Workers in more than 40 countries. Along with the Co-Workers, the lay Missionaries of Charity try to follow Mother Teresa's spirit and charism in their families.

Mother Teresa's work has been recognised and acclaimed throughout the world and she has received a number of awards and distinctions, including the Pope John XXIII Peace Prize (1971) and the Nehru Prize for her promotion of international peace and understanding (1972). She also received the Balzan Prize (1979) and the Templeton and Magsaysay awards.

3. Balancing the ratio of male – female.

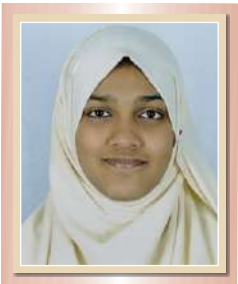

1. Low child sex ratio called for the launch of the scheme

The child sex ratio (CSR) census data for 0-6 years was 933 girls per 1,000 boys in 2001, which declined to 918 girls for every 1,000 boys in 2011. UNICEF in 2012 reported that India ranked 41st among 195 countries. A 2011 population census revealed that the population ratio of India in 2011 was 943 females per 1,000 of males. The sex ratio 2011, however, indications an upward trend from the census 2001 data.

1. Crime against women on the rise

Aborting of Female Foeticide by post ultrasonic testing. Thus this type of discrimination against girl infants resulted in a huge drop in the female population. Also, crimes and sex abuse, so on, have been on a constant high. Back in the year 2014, Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi spoke on the event of International Day of the girl child. POVERTY

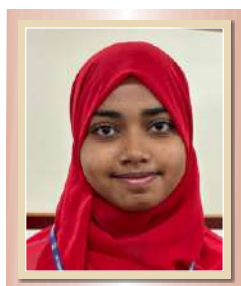

"BETI BACHAO BETI PADHAO"

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao is a campaign of the Government of India. It mainly targeted in Bihar, Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh.

BACKGROUND OF THE TOPIC:

The child sex ratio in India had been going down at a continuous rate. In the population census of 2011 the child sex ratio in India was 919 girls aged 0 to 6 years old. During the 2014 International Day of the girl child, Narendra Modi asked the public to help and stand against the sexism happening with girls in India.

The Beti Bachao Beti Padhao [BBBP] scheme was launched on 22nd January 2015 by Prime Minister, Narendra Modi. It aims to address the issues of the declining child sex ratio image [CSR] and it is national initiative jointly seen by the ministry of women and child development, the ministry of health, and family welfare and the ministry of education. It initially focused on multi sector action in 100 districts throughout the country, where there was a low child sex ratio [CSR].

On 26 August 2016 Olympics bronze medalist Sakshi Malik, was made brand ambassador for [BBBP]. The hash tag # selfie with daughter was promoted on social media in June 2015, which started when Sunil Jagla the sarpanch of the village. Bibipur Jind in Haryana took a selfie with his daughter Nandini and posted on face book on 9th June 2015, the hash tag garnered worldwide fame.

REASONS FOR THIS INITIATIVE:

Sex selective abortion on female foeticide has led to a sharp drop in the ratio of girls born in contrast to boys infants. In some states in India ultrasound technology has made it possible pregnant women and their families to earn the sex of a foetus early in a pregnancy.

Discrimination against girl infants, for several reasons has combined with the technology to result in a rise in abortion of fetuses identified as female during ultrasonic testing.

The trend was first noticed when results of the 1991 national census were released and were confirmed to be a worsening problem when results of the 2001 national census were released. The reduction in the female population of certain Indian states continues to worsen, as results of the 2011 national census have shown.

It has been observed that the trend is most pronounced in relatively prosperous regions of India, the dowry system in India is often blamed; the expectation that a large dowry must be provided for daughters for them to marry is frequently cited as a major cause for the problem. Pressure for parents to provide large dowries for their daughters is most intense in prosperous states where high standards of living, and modern consumerism, are more prevalent in Indian society. **SAVE DAUGHTER, EDUCATE THE DAUGHTER.**

बेटी बचाओ बेटी पढ़ाओ

शिक्षा प्रत्येक बच्चे के जीवन के सबसे महत्वपूर्ण चरणों में से एक है, जिससे बच्चों को सामाजिक और शैक्षिक रूप से विकसित होने का अवसर मिलता है ! शिक्षा न केवल किसी देश के आर्थिक विकास के लिए महत्वपूर्ण है, बल्कि व्यक्ति के आर्थिक सशक्तिकरण पर भी इसका व्यापक प्रभाव पड़ता है !

लड़कियों को शिक्षित करने में प्राथमिक बाधाएँ क्या हैं ?

शोध से पता चला है कि शिक्षा तक पहुँचने से लड़कियाँ अनुपातहीन रूप से प्रभावित होती हैं !

सांस्कृतिक विश्वास और पितृसत्तात्मक मूल्य :

कुछ संस्कृतियों में लड़कियों की शिक्षा अभी भी पूरी तरह से प्रतिबंधित है ! जबकी लड़को को स्कूल भेजा जाता है, लड़कियों के जन्म देने, बच्चों की परवरिश करने और घरेलू काम करने के अवसरों को काफी कम कर दिया जाता है ! ये सांस्कृतिक मान्यताएँ पितृसत्तात्मक परंपराओं के भीतर फँसी हुई हैं!

गरीबी

विश्व बैंक के अनुसार, लड़कियों की शिक्षा में गरीबी सबसे महत्वपूर्ण योगदान कारकों में से एक है ! जब परिवार शिक्षा का खर्च वहन नहीं कर सकता, तो लड़को की तुलना में लड़कियों के स्कूल छोड़ने की संभावना बहुत अधिक होती है ! लड़कियाँ अक्सर छोटे भाई-बहनो की देखभाल करने के लिए घर में रहती हैं और घर के काम का मुख्य बोझ उठती हैं !

शीघ्र विवाह और गर्भावस्था :

प्रारंभिक विवाह और गर्भावस्था शिक्षा में महत्वपूर्ण लिंग अंतर में एक भूमिका निभाते हैं यूनिसेफ के अनुसार, अनुमानित रूप से 18 वर्ष से कम उम्र की 39000 लड़कियों की हर दिन शादी की जाती है !

संघर्ष, हिंसा और स्कूल की खतरनाक यात्रा :

दुनिया भर में लड़कियों को समाज में हिंसा और यौन हिंसा का बहुत अधिक खतरा है ! स्कूल के लिए लम्बी दूरी अक्सर कई लड़कियों के लिए आम है जहाँ समुदायों में कोई परिवहन उपलब्ध नहीं है !

मानसिक धर्म और महिला जननांग विकृति :

लड़कियों के जीव विज्ञान की अनिवार्यता का अर्थ है की मानसिक धर्म लड़कियों की शिक्षा में बाधा के रूप में कार्य कर सकता है ! कई गरीबी समुदायों में, सैनिटरी उत्पाद एक विकल्प नहीं हैं और अक्सर स्कूल में उपलब्ध नहीं कराए जाते हैं !

क्या होता है जब हम लड़कियों की शिक्षा में निवेश करते हैं ?

लड़कियों की शिक्षा यकीनन वैश्विक अर्थव्यवस्था के लिए सबसे अच्छा निवेश है ! यह अनुमान लगाया है कि देशों को समझाए गए \$15 ट्रिलियन और \$30 ट्रिलियन की जीवन भर की उत्पादकता और कमाई का नुकसान होता है !

हालाँकि, सबसे महत्वपूर्ण बात यह है कि लड़कियों की शिक्षा में निवेश करने से बाल विवाह दर घटती है, बाल मृत्यु दर गिरती है, मातृ मृत्यु दर गिरती है और स्वास्थ्य में नाटकीय रूप से सुधार होता है ! शिक्षित महिलाएँ अपने स्वस्थ परिवार, वित्त और भविष्य की आकांक्षाओं के लिए बेहतर निर्णय लेती हैं !

लिंग और सामाजिक मानदंडों को बदलने के लिए समाज के सभी स्तरों पर संचार, अभियान, शिक्षा और वकालत महत्वपूर्ण है ! सामाजिक मानदंडों को बदलना हमेशा एक बहुत धीमी प्रक्रिया होती है और विभिन्न दिशाओं से हस्तक्षेप की आवश्यकता होती है ! जमीनी स्तर पर प्रचार करना भी उतना ही महत्वपूर्ण है, जितना कि राज्य, समुदाय और धार्मिक नेताओं को शिक्षित करना है !
